JUNE 2010's Monthly Index of Economic Activity, IMACEC

According to preliminary information, last June the Imacec increased 6.8% over the same month a year before. The seasonally-adjusted series rose 0.8% with respect to the previous month, while the cyclical trend series recorded an annualized expansion of 5.6%. The month came with the same number of working days as June 2009.

The result of the month reflected the strength of wholesale and retail Trade, Transport, and Electricity, gas & water.

In accordance with the public, pre-defined calendar of National Accounts disclosure, preliminary GDP figures corresponding to the second quarter 2010 will be published next 18 August.
